CHRIST THE KING PLAQUE

A fun craft activity for children and adults alike! Hot glue gun involved so younger ones will require some assistance.

Material:

- · Thick board/cardboard
- Pencil
- Hot glue gun
- PVA glue and paint brush
- Aluminium foil
- · Permanent markers in various colours
- Printout of CathFamily Christ the King design template (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Use a pencil to draw your design onto the board using the CathFamily design or be creative and draw your own.
- 2. Trace over the design with the hot glue (simple designs are best as the glue is quite chunky).
- 3. Spread PVA glue evenly over the board and hot glue parts.
- 4. Place the aluminium foil (shiny side down) lightly on the board. Starting at the middle and working outwards, use your finger tip or the end of a rounded pencil to gently press the foil into the grooves.
- 5. Fold the edges of the foil over and affix to the back with more PVA glue.
- Colour your design using the permanent markers.
